


### FLATIRON PLAZAS PEDESTRIAN ACTIVITY



The first quarter of the year began with lower pedestrian volumes through the Flatiron Public Plazas in January (-40% compared to December 2021) due in part to multiple winter storms and concerns over the Omicron variant. More people returned to the heart of Flatiron beginning in mid-February increasing the Q1 visitor count to over 4 million (45,119/day). Spring began on March 20<sup>th</sup> increasing the month's average (52,439/day) to 83% of pre-pandemic volumes.
