Q3 2020 welcomed an increasing number of people to the Flatiron Public Plazas. Compared to <u>last quarter</u>, there were, on average, 2,104 additional people traversing the plazas each day, a 60% increase from lows set in April (15,639/day). September was the busiest month on the plazas since mid-March, with a high of 34,043 pedestrians counted on September 19th.

<u>NY Forward</u> phased reopenings continued into the quarter including personal care businesses on July 6th, and gyms and fitness studios on September 2nd. After Labor Day, there was a 30% increase from July and August, which became more pronounced with the academic year beginning and office occupancy inching upward across the city.
