
## Flatiron Plaza Pedestrian Counts Q4 2020

## FLATIRON PLAZAS DAILY PEDESTRIAN COUNTS (JANUARY - DECEMBER 2020)



In Q4 2020, the number of people passing through the Flatiron Public Plazas continued its steady increase in October and November before dropping slightly in December. On average, there were an additional 7,063 people passing through the heart of Flatiron this quarter, a 33% increase from <u>last quarter</u>. On November 7, over 47,000 pedestrians visited the Flatiron Public Plazas, the highest volume since March 14.

Prior to pandemic restrictions beginning in mid-March, pedestrian volumes averaged around 62,000/day. Since the reported lows in April (15,639/day), pedestrian traffic has slowly returned to Flatiron's Public Plazas, rising steadily through June (21,685/day) before levelling off for the summer months. Post Labor Day, pedestrian volume continued to increase through November, topping off at a daily pedestrian average above 30,000/day. As 2020 came to a close, December operated at 41% of typical volume compared year-over-year.
